Federal Financial Aid for DAOM Studies

Oregon College of Oriental Medicine (OCOM) offers Federal Financial Aid to DAOM students in the form of loans for those who qualify.

To apply for Federal Financial Aid, you must do so every year. You can apply beginning October 1, 2021 for the 2022-2023 academic year. Continuing students apply after October 1 for the next academic year. File your Free Application for Federal Student Aid, or **FAFSA**, online at <https://studentaid.gov/h/apply-for-aid/fafsa>.

Begin by creating a FSA user ID and password to ensure that your personal information is secure. Next, on your FAFSA, select OCOM as the college you wish to receive your information. **OCOM's school code is B-07625.**

Upon admission to OCOM, your FAFSA information is reviewed and an aid offer is prepared. You will then be asked to return the signed aid offer materials so that your aid can be processed.

Loan funds will arrive at the beginning of each semester — once in September and again in March — just before you are charged for your tuition. *A Direct Graduate PLUS Loan can provide additional funding up to the cost of attendance.*
