Your 2022-2023 FAFSA was selected for a process called verification. U.S. Department of Education regulations state that before awarding federal student aid, we must ask you to confirm the information you reported on your FAFSA. If there are differences between your application information and your financial documents, we will make the appropriate corrections to your FAFSA. You must complete and sign this worksheet, attach any required documents and submit them to us. After review, we may ask for additional information.
