Total Amount of Each Award — Up to \$10,000 per award in unrestricted grants, including:

- Reimbursed relocation and related expenses, up to \$3,500
- New practice start-up funds: \$6,500*

Awarded to — Incoming students (Fall 2015) in the OCOM **Master of Acupuncture and Oriental Medicine (MAcOM)** program, who meet geographic residency requirements and have been a continuous resident in an eligible U.S. state for the past 24 calendar months.
